

# Grant Funding


## Cons

- Difficult to locate
- Rarely 100%
- Only certain eligible costs
- Paid out in instalments and arrears
- Can be very competitive
- Can be distracting
- Can be paperwork heavy

## Pros

- Will accept higher risk
- Seen as zero cost
- No dilution of ownership
- Can add to credibility
- Can act as leverage





# Getting Ready for a Application - Preparation


Business Model Canvas: Answering these questions will help with most grant application



# Working with partners

- What is the relationship? Partner or Subcontractor?
- Find the right partners as part of your business innovation journey
- Build relations before before calls come out
- Agree who is doing what and who gets what
  - Intellectual Property
  - Finance
  - Memorandum of Understanding
- Stick to your business plan, don't be pulled in the wrong direction when calls get announced.


